Below are the units we will be studying this term.

English

Responding to Texts

In this unit, students will have multiple opportunities read, examine and respond to literature and explore text structure and organisation. Students will create a short imaginative text which include illustrations.



When learning about stories they will be:

- Exploring stories
- Understanding stories
- Exploring characters in stories
- Writing a story to share

Maths

Students have opportunities to develop understandings of:

Numbers to twenty - represent quantities, compare numbers, match number names, numerals and quantities, identify parts within whole, combine collections, make equal groups and describe the joining process.



Using units of measurement - directly and indirectly compare the duration of events, directly and indirectly technologies and processes to make compare the mass, length and capacity of objects.

Science

Move it Move it



Students use their senses to observe and explore the properties and movement of objects. Students will engage in hands-on investigations and respond to questions about the factors that influence movement. They will share and reflect on observations and ideas, and represent what they observe.

HASS

Students will continue to observe, identify and represent the location and features of places using pictorial maps and models. Students will reflect on the actions farmers are taking to care for farms and the animals, crops and trees they grow.

Physical Education

Prep students will have one 30 minute Physical Education lesson each week. Children participate will in perceptual motor program where they will develop their gross motor skills.



Health

I am safe

Students identify actions and protective behaviours that keep them safe and healthy in situations where they may encounter medicines, poisons, water and fires.

Music

Prep students will have one 30 minute Music lesson each week with Ms Woodruff. Children will participate in a variety of musical activities including singing and listening, and beat and rhythm games.



Human Movement

Students will participate in one 30 minute Human Movement lesson per week. In this unit, students will make and respond to dance and drama by exploring shapes and objects using voice and movement.

Visual Arts

This term students will explore ideas, experiences, observations and imagination to create visual artworks.

They will use and experiment with different materials, techniques, artworks.



Japanese

Children in Prep will have one 30 minute Japanese lesson each week. Students will learn to greet, introduce and describe themselves to new friends. They will use Japanese to exchange gifts. Students will continue to develop their knowledge of hiragana.
