Each school review generates a number of key improvement strategies to inform continuous improvement in all state schools. The next steps are...

- Ensure a collaborative approach is taken in setting the strategic direction of the school that values traditions, explores new opportunities to improve and meets the aspirations of staff and community members.
- Collaboratively review and refine the explicit improvement agenda ensuring all staff develop a deep understanding of the key strategies and practices informing school improvement, teaching and learning and aligned targets for student achievement.
- Deepen all staff understanding of the Australian Curriculum through continuous professional development, time for collaborative planning and the implementation of the four phases of moderation.
- Build all staff capability by establishing agreed processes to regularly share and strengthen pedagogical practice through watching others work, coaching, mentoring, observation and feedback.
- Collaboratively develop a whole-school approach to inclusion and inclusive practices, with clear roles, responsibilities and accountabilities for all staff to ensure every student is succeeding.
