NATIONAL ASSESSMENT PROGRAMME LITERACY & NUMERACY STUDENT REPORTS

In May, all students in Years 3, 5, 7 & 9 across Australia participated in the National Assessment Programme [which includes] Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) tests. The NAPLAN tests, conducted over three days, included assessments in reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy. Every student who participated in these tests received an individual report outlining their achievement. This report provides a range of information about each child's relative performance in literacy and numeracy from the NAPLAN tests compared with results of students from across Australia. The NAPLAN tests provide an important point-in-time snapshot of your child's achievement but should be considered along with the range of other performance information collected by our school. Presently, teachers are reviewing scored student performance to identify school curriculum enhancements that can further improve student learning into 2020.

The McDowall State School is pleased to publish NAPLAN 2019 data released to date.
